AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 348, Page 21, Section 115.601, Line 48,  
by inserting after all of said Section and Line the following:

"162.459. 1. Notwithstanding other provisions of law to the contrary, the school board of  
each school district designated in the statutes as a seven-director, seven-director or urban school  
district[, except an urban district containing the greater part of a city of more than three hundred  
thousand inhabitants,] shall consist of seven members. At the first election for members of the  
school board in each of such districts after January 1, 1993, and each three years thereafter, three  
members of the school board shall be elected; except, no school district composed of seven members  
as of January 1, 1993, shall be required to modify its schedule of electing board members.

2. Provisions of law applicable to seven-director, seven-director and urban school districts,  
except those which conflict with the provisions of this section, shall apply to and govern the school  
districts designated in subsection 1 of this section.

162.471. The government and control of an urban school district is vested in a board of  
seven directors[, except that in urban districts containing the greater part of a city of more than three  
hundred thousand inhabitants the board shall be composed of nine directors]. Each director shall be  
a voter of the district, who has resided within this state for one year next preceding his election or  
appointment and who is at least twenty-four years of age. All directors, except as otherwise  
provided in section 162.481 and section 162.492, hold their offices for six years and until their  
successors are duly elected and qualified. All vacancies occurring in the board, except as provided in

1 section 162.492, shall be filled by appointment by the board as soon as practicable, and the person  
2 appointed shall hold his office until the next school board election, when his successor shall be  
3 elected for the remainder of the unexpired term. The power of the board to perform any official duty  
4 during the existence of a vacancy continues unimpaired thereby."; and

6 Further amend said bill, Section 162.481, Page 22, Line 39, by deleting the number: "2014" on said  
7 Line and inserting in lieu thereof the number: "2016"; and

8  
9 Further amend said bill, Section 162.492, Page 22, Line 11, by enclosing in brackets the number:  
10 "1969" on said Line and inserting immediately thereafter the following: "2015"; and

12 Further amend said Section, Page, and Line by enclosing in brackets the word: "six" on said Line and  
13 inserting immediately thereafter the word: "three"; and

15 Further amend said Section and Page, Line 19 by deleting the number: "2014" on said Line and  
16 inserting in lieu thereof the number: "2016"; and

17  
18 Further amend said Section, Page 23, Lines 23 - 25, by deleting all of said Lines from the bill and  
19 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

21 "election of 2016, there shall be seven members of the board; three shall reside in and be designated  
22 for election according to the subdistricts as provided under subsection 2 of this section; four shall  
23 reside anywhere in the"; and

24 Further amend said Section, Page 23, Line 29, by removing the phrase: "six [and the directors" from  
25 said Line and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

26 "three [six and the directors"; and

27 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
28 accordingly.
