1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 415, Pages 83 and 84 , Section 301.3142,  
2 Lines 1 through 41, by deleting all of said section and lines and inserting in lieu thereof the  
3 following:

5 "301.3142. 1. Any immediate family member, including stepsiblings or stepchildren, who  
6 wishes to pay tribute to a member of the United States military who was a resident of this state and  
7 who was killed in the line of duty may receive special personalized license plates as prescribed by  
8 this section, for any motor vehicle such person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an  
9 apportioned motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen thousand  
10 pounds gross weight.

11 2. Any such person shall make application for the special license plates on a form provided  
12 by the director of revenue and furnish such proof of eligibility as the director may require.

13 3. Upon [annual application payment of a fifteen dollar fee in addition to the registration fee,  
14 and presentation of any other documents which may be required by law or upon biennial application,  
15 payment of a thirty dollar fee in addition to the registration fee and] presentation of such proof of  
16 eligibility [for such plates] and payment of the regular registration fees, and presentation of any  
17 [other] documents which may be required by law, the [department] director of revenue [may] shall  
18 issue to the vehicle owner a special personalized license plate which shall bear the initials of the  
19 member of the United States military killed while in the line of duty, a gold star on the left side of the  
20 plates, followed by a three-letter description of the relative's relation to the veteran, provided such  
21 license plate configuration is not currently in use, and [which shall bear] the words "WE SHALL  
22 NOT FORGET" [in place of the words "SHOW-ME STATE"] at the bottom of the plate, in a manner  
23 prescribed by the director of revenue. Such license plates shall be made with fully reflective  
24 material with a common color scheme and design, shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be  
25 aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130.

26 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 301.144, no additional fee shall be charged for  
27 the personalization of license plates pursuant to this section.

28 5. There shall be no limit on the number of license plates any person qualified under this  
29 section may obtain so long as each set of license plates issued under this section is issued for vehicles  
30 owned solely or jointly by such person.

31 [3.] 6. License plates issued pursuant to the provisions of this section shall not be  
32 transferable to any other person except that any registered co-owner of the motor vehicle shall be

1 entitled to operate the motor vehicle with such plates for the duration of the year licensed in the  
2 event of the death of the qualified person.

3 7. The director [of revenue] shall make all necessary rules and regulations for the  
4 administration of this section, and shall design all necessary forms required by this section. Any rule  
5 or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority  
6 delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the  
7 provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are  
8 nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to  
9 review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held  
10 unconstitutional, then the grant of rule making authority and any rule proposed or adopted after  
11 August 28, [2004] 2013, shall be invalid and void."; and
