1 AMEND House Bill No. 616, Page 1, Section 161.855, by striking all of said section and inserting  
2 in lieu thereof the following:

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4 "161.855. 1. The department of elementary and secondary education shall conduct at least  
5 one public hearing in each congressional district in Missouri prior to the full implementation of the  
6 common core state standards. The public hearings shall provide an opportunity for members of the  
7 general public to publicly testify regarding the common core state standards. The commissioner of  
8 education and at least one member of the state board of education shall attend each public hearing.  
9 For each public hearing, the department shall provide at least two weeks' notice to school districts  
10 and parents of public school students located within the congressional district in which the hearing  
11 shall be held.

12 2. At least two weeks prior to the first of the public hearings, the department of elementary  
13 and secondary education shall perform and make publicly available a fiscal analysis of the projected  
14 cost to the state and school districts of the implementation of the common core state standards. The  
15 analysis shall include the costs of material, equipment, technology, and training, as well as any  
16 savings that may be realized. The department shall provide the fiscal analysis to the president pro  
17 tempore of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, and to the joint committee on  
18 education. The department shall publish the fiscal analysis on its internet website.

19 3. At least two weeks prior to the first of the public hearings, the department of elementary  
20 and secondary education shall prepare a report that identifies:

21 (1) Any data that shall be collected as a result of the implementation of the common core  
22 state standards; and

23 (2) Any governmental entity, quasi-governmental entity, or consortium that collects data or  
24 receives data as a result of the implementation of the common core state standards.

25 4. The department of elementary and secondary education shall submit the report required  
26 under subsection 3 of this section to the president pro tempore of the senate, the speaker of the house  
27 of representatives, and to the joint committee on education. The department shall publish the report  
28 on its internet website. The department shall notify parents of public school students of the data  
29 collection procedures described in subsection 3 of this section.

30 5. The department of elementary and secondary education shall conduct all of the public  
31 hearings by December 31, 2013.

32 Section B. Because of the importance of providing information to the public about the

2 preservation of the public health, welfare, peace and safety, and is hereby declared to be an  
3 emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and section A of this act shall be in full force  
4 and effect upon its passage and approval."; and

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7 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
8 accordingly.

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
