1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 859, Page 4,
2 Section 571.030, Line 28, by inserting after the word "board" the
3 following:

4 ": or

5 (11) Commits a felony offense while in possession of an
6 otherwise lawfully concealed firearm, regardless of whether the
7 firearm was used in the commission of a felony offense"; and
8

9 Further amend said bill, Page 9, Section 571.182, Line 56,
10 by inserting after the word "effect" the following:

11 ":

12 (12) Has not had his or her concealed carry endorsement
13 permanently revoked under section 571.185"; and
14

15 Further amend said bill, Page 14, Section 571.184, Line 75,
16 by inserting after all of said line the following:

17 "571.185. 1. A concealed carry permit issued under
18 sections 571.180 to 571.198 shall be suspended upon the filing
19 with the court of an indictment or information charging the
20 concealed carry permit holder with unlawful use of a weapon under
21 subdivision (11) of subsection 1 of section 571.182. The court
22 shall immediately order the suspension of such concealed carry
23 permit and cause notification of the suspension to be made to the
24 concealed carry permit holder.

25 2. Upon notification of the suspension order, the holder of
26 the concealed carry permit shall immediately surrender the
27 concealed carry permit to the officer or other official serving
28 the notice of suspension.

29 3. The officer or other official to whom the concealed

1 carry permit is surrendered shall transmit the concealed carry
2 permit to the circuit court of the county issuing the order. The
3 concealed carry permit shall be suspended until the order is
4 terminated, the charge or indictment is dismissed or until the
5 concealed carry permit holder is found not guilty of the charge
6 of violating subdivision (11) of subsection 1 of section 571.182.
7 Upon dismissal of the charge or a finding of not guilty, the
8 court holding the concealed carry permit shall return it to the
9 individual. Upon a plea of guilty or a finding of guilt to the
10 charge, the concealed carry permit shall be permanently revoked.
11 The court shall forward a notice of the plea or conviction along
12 with the concealed carry permit to the sheriff of the county
13 which issued the certificate of qualification for a concealed
14 carry permit and shall report the change in status of the
15 concealed carry permit to the Missouri uniform law enforcement
16 system."; and

18 Further amend said title, enacting clause and intersectional
19 references accordingly.
