1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 867, Page 1, in the Title, Line 3, by deleting the words "road district" and
2 inserting in lieu thereof the words "political subdivisions"; and

4 Further amend said bill, Page 6, Section 233.295, Line 125, by inserting the following after all of
5 said line:

7 "238.212. 1. If the petition was filed by registered voters or by a governing body, the
8 circuit clerk in whose office the petition was filed shall give notice to the public by causing one or
9 more newspapers of general circulation serving the counties or portions thereof contained in the
10 proposed district to publish once a week for four consecutive weeks a notice substantially in the
11 following form:

13 NOTICE OF PETITION TO SUBMIT TO A POPULAR VOTE THE CREATION AND
14 FUNDING OF A TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

16 Notice is hereby given to all persons residing or owning property in (here specifically
17 describe the proposed district boundaries), within the state of Missouri, that a petition has been filed
18 asking that upon voter approval, a transportation development district by the name of ".....
19 Transportation Development District" be formed for the purpose of developing the following
20 transportation project: (here summarize the proposed transportation project or projects). The
21 petition also requests voter approval of the following method(s) of funding the district, which (may)
22 (shall not) increase the total taxes imposed within the proposed district: (describe the proposed
23 funding methods). A copy of this petition is on file and available at the office of the clerk of the
24 circuit court of

25 County, located at, Missouri. You are notified to join in or file your own petition
26 supporting or answer opposing the creation of the transportation development district and requesting
27 a declaratory judgment, as required by law, no later than the day of, 20.. . You
28 may show cause, if any there be, why such petition is defective or proposed transportation
29 development district or its funding method, as set forth in the petition, is illegal or unconstitutional
30 and should not be submitted for voter approval at a general, primary or special election as directed
31 by this court.

35 2. (1) If the petition for creating such district was filed by registered voters or by a

2 deems appropriate.

3 (2) If the petition for creating such district was filed by the owners of record of all real
4 property within the proposed district, the circuit court shall order at least one public hearing on the
5 creation and funding of the proposed district[, if the petition for creating such district was filed by
6 the owners of record of all real property within the proposed district].

7 (3) If a public hearing is ordered under subdivision (1) of subsection 2 of this section, notice
8 of the time, date and place of the hearing shall also be given in the notice specified in subsection 1
9 of this section."; and

11 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
12 accordingly.
