1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill No. 919, Page 2, Section 311.090, Line 35, by inserting immediately after all of said line  
3 the following:

5 "311.091. 1. Except as provided under subsection 2 of this section and notwithstanding any  
6 other provisions of this chapter to the contrary, any person who possesses the qualifications required  
7 by this chapter and who meets the requirements of and complies with the provisions of this chapter  
8 may apply for and the supervisor of alcohol and tobacco control may issue a license to sell  
9 intoxicating liquor, as defined in this chapter, by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises  
10 of any boat, or other vessel licensed by the United States Coast Guard to carry [one hundred] thirty  
11 or more passengers for hire on navigable waters in or adjacent to this state, which has a regular  
12 place of mooring in a location in this state or within two hundred yards of a location which would  
13 otherwise be licensable under this chapter. The license shall be valid even though the boat, or other  
14 vessel, leaves its regular place of mooring during the course of its operation.

15 2. [Any person who possesses the qualifications required by this chapter and who meets the  
16 requirements of, and complies with the provisions of, this chapter may apply for, and the supervisor  
17 of alcohol and tobacco control may issue, a license to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail  
18 for consumption on the premises of any boat or other vessel licensed by the United States Coast  
19 Guard to carry forty-five to ninety-nine passengers for hire on a lake with a shoreline that is in three  
20 counties, one of which is any county of the third classification without a township form of  
21 government and with more than thirty-three thousand but fewer than thirty-seven thousand  
22 inhabitants and with a city of the fourth classification with more than three thousand but fewer than  
23 three thousand seven hundred inhabitants as the county seat, one of which is any county of the third  
24 classification without a township form of government and with more than twenty-nine thousand but  
25 fewer than thirty-three thousand inhabitants and with a city of the fourth classification with more  
26 than four hundred but fewer than four hundred fifty inhabitants as the county seat, and one of which  
27 is any county of the first classification with more than fifty thousand but fewer than seventy  
28 thousand inhabitants. The boat must have a regular place of mooring in a location in this state or  
29 within two hundred yards of a location which would otherwise be licensable under this chapter. The  
30 license shall be valid even though the boat, or other vessel, leaves its regular place of mooring  
31 during the course of its operation.

32 3.] For every license for sale of liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises  
33 of any boat or other vessel issued under the provisions of this section, the licensee shall pay to the  
34 director of revenue the sum of three hundred dollars per year."; and
