## Offered By

AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1368, Page 2, Section 173.900, Line 47, by inserting immediately after said section and line the following:
"253.570. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as the "Veterans Opportunity Act."
2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the department of natural resources shall sell all property known as the Eleven Point State Park to comply with the recorded scenic easement for the Eleven Point National Scenic River between Reed Wayne Pigman, Jr. and the United States, which was signed on August 21, 1979. The property shall be sold at public auction in tracts of at least three hundred acres. Military veterans and the immediate family members of any member of the military who was killed in action or declared missing in action shall be given preference for the purchase of such property in the public auction. Any property not purchased by such individuals in the public auction shall then be offered to members of the general public at public auction. Any property not purchased at public auction shall remain on the real estate market until such time as all property is sold. The department of natural resources shall be required to cover the regular maintenance costs of such property including, but not limited to, bush hogging and maintaining fences until such time as all property is sold.
3. Proceeds from the sale of such property shall be deposited in the state park maintenance fund and shall be used solely for state park maintenance and for remediation efforts outlined in the settlement agreement between ASARCO, L.L.C., the United States, the state of Missouri, and the Doe Run Company in 2008."; and

Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
