2 Senate Bill No. 152, Page 66, Section 173.1003, Line 68, by inserting after all of said section and
3 line the following:

5 "173.1352. 1. As used in this section, the following terms mean:

6 (1) "Advanced placement examination", any examination administered through the College
7 Board's Advanced Placement Program (AP);

8 (2) "Board", the coordinating board for higher education created in section 173.005;

9 (3) "Institution", any in-state public community college, college, or university that offers
10 postsecondary freshman-level courses.

11 2. (1) Each institution shall adopt and implement a policy to grant undergraduate course
12 credit to entering freshman students for each advanced placement examination upon which such
13 student achieves a score of three or higher.

14 (2) In the policy, the institution shall:

15 (a) Establish the institution's conditions for granting course credit; and

16 (b) Based on the correlations identified under subsection 4 of this section, identify the
17 specific course credit or other academic requirements of the institution, including the number of
18 semester credit hours or other course credit, that the institution will grant to a student who achieves
19 required scores on advanced placement examinations.

20 3. On request of an applicant for admission as an entering freshman, and based on
21 information provided by the applicant, an institution shall determine and notify the applicant
22 regarding:

23 (1) The amount and type of any course credit that would be granted to the applicant under
24 the policy; and

25 (2) Any other academic requirement that the applicant would satisfy under the policy.

26 4. The board, in consultation with the department of elementary and secondary education,
27 shall identify correlations between the subject matter and content of courses offered by each
28 institution and the subject matter and content of courses and examinations in the advanced
29 placement program, and shall make that information available to the public on the board's website.";
