1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill
2 No. 152, Page 22, Section 161.1050, Line 31, by inserting at the end of said section and line the following:

4 "162.012. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

5 (1) "School-sponsored activity", any activity sponsored by a school including, but not limited to,
6 participation in a work-based learning program in which training or work activities are conducted at the
7 premises of or under the direction of an employer participating in the program;

8 (2) "Work-based learning program", the same meaning given to the term in section 170.038.

9 2. The school board of any school district may purchase insurance contracts to insure against loss,
10 damages, or expenses incident to a claim arising out of the sickness, bodily injury, or death by accident of any
11 student injured on school premises or during school-sponsored activities. For purposes of this subsection,
12 travel to and from any work-based learning program shall constitute a school-sponsored activity.

13 3. The school board of any school district may purchase insurance contracts for the benefit of
14 students to insure against loss resulting from the loss of, theft of, or damage to the personal property of
15 students while on school premises or during school-sponsored activities."; and

17 Further amend said bill, Page 60, Section 170.029, Line 48, by inserting after all of said section and line the
18 following:

20 "170.038. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

21 (1) "Secondary education", education of students who attend secondary schools;

22 (2) "Secondary school", a public school giving instruction in a grade or grades not lower than the
23 sixth nor higher than the twelfth grade;

24 (3) "Work-based learning program", a learning program in a secondary education curriculum that:

25 (a) Includes, but is not limited to, work study, on-the-job training, job shadowing, internships,
26 clinicals, practicums, cooperative projects, and industry-led service-learning projects;

27 (b) Is incorporated into coursework or related to a specific field of study; and

28 (c) Integrates knowledge and theory learned in the classroom with the practical application and
29 development of technical skills and proficiencies in a professional work setting.

30 2. An employer who accepts a secondary school student in a work-based learning program shall not
31 be subject to civil liability for any claim arising from the student's negligent act or omission.

32 3. Nothing in this section shall provide immunity for gross negligence or willful misconduct."; and

34 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
