1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for
2 Senate Bill No. 152, Page 61, Section 170.047, Line 24, by inserting after all of said section and line
3 the following:

5 "170.352. 1. As used in this section, "critical race theory" shall include any curriculum that
6 does any of the following:

7 (1) Identifies people, entities, or institutions as inherently, immutably, or systemically sexist,
8 racist, biased, privileged, or oppressed;

9 (2) Employs immutable, inherited, or objective characteristics such as race, income,
10 appearance, family of origin, or sexual orientation in the service of:

11 (a) Defining a person's "identity";

12 (b) Classifying persons into groups for any purpose, including for the purpose of targeting
13 only certain groups for education, formation, indoctrination, viewpoint or transformation;

14 (c) Perpetuating stereotypes; or

15 (d) Assigning blame to categories of persons, regardless of the actions of particular
16 individuals.

17 2. Curricula implementing critical race theory include, but are not limited to:

18 (1) The 1619 Project initiative of the New York Times;

19 (2) The Learning for Justice Curriculum of the Southern Poverty Law Center, along with its
20 predecessor, Teaching Tolerance, and any successor curricula;

21 (3) We Stories;

22 (4) Programs of Educational Equity Consultants; and

23 (5) All similar and successor curricula.

24 3. A school district or charter school shall notify the parent or legal guardian of each student
25 enrolled in the district or school of:

26 (1) The basic content of the district's or school's curriculum promoting critical race theory
27 and upon request shall provide to the parents or guardians of any student any curriculum, material,
28 test, survey, questionnaire, activity, or instruction of any kind related to critical race theory,
29 regardless of whether such curriculum is offered as part of an elective course or as part of any civic,
30 history, or english class, activity, or program; and

31 (2) The parent's right to remove the student from any part of the district's or school's
32 instruction relating to critical race theory or from any part of a curriculum, material, test, survey,
33 questionnaire, activity, or instruction of any kind related to critical race theory regardless of whether
34 offered as part of classroom instruction or as part of any other class, activity, or program.

35 4. A school district or charter school shall make all curriculum materials used in the
36 district's or school's critical race instruction and any curriculum materials, test, survey,

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1 questionnaire, activity, or instruction of any kind related to critical race theory, regardless of
2 whether offered as part of classroom instruction or as part of any other class, activity, or program,
3 available for public inspection pursuant to chapter 610 prior to the use of such materials in actual
4 instruction.

5 5. Unless a specific curriculum relating to critical race theory is approved by the board of
6 the school district or the governing body of the charter school no school district, charter school, or
7 personnel or agent of such school district or charter school shall:

8 (1) Teach, use, or provide for use by any pupil any curriculum implementing critical race
9 theory as part of any curriculum, course materials, or instruction in any course given in such school
10 district or charter school; or

11 (2) Teach, affirm, or promote as an accurate account or representation of the founding and
12 history of the United States of America any of the claims, views, or opinions presented in the 1619
13 Project as part of any curriculum, course materials, or instruction in any course given in such school
14 district or charter school."; and

16 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
17 accordingly.
