15	Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following and renumbering the original section 2 to

18	2 Revenue Stabilization Reserve Account. Amend RSA 9:13-e, II to read as follows:
19	II. There is hereby established within the general fund general ledger a revenue
20	stabilization reserve account. At the close of the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2001, and at the
21	close of each fiscal biennium thereafter, any surplus, as determined by the official audit performed
22	pursuant to RSA 21-I:8, $II(a)$ shall be transferred by the comptroller to a special nonlapsing revenue
23	stabilization reserve account[; provided, however, that in any single fiscal year the total of such
24	$transfer\ shall\ not\ exceed\ 1/2\ of\ the\ total\ potential\ maximum\ balance\ allowable\ under\ paragraph\ V].$
25	The comptroller is hereby directed to establish the revenue stabilization reserve account in which to
