1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

7 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 3 with the following:

9            4 Fish and Game Department; Report on Registration Alternatives. The executive director of  
10 the fish and game department shall work in conjunction with the New Hampshire Off Highway  
11 Vehicle Association to study registration alternatives for OHRV users who do not use organized  
12 trail systems. The executive director shall report any findings or recommendations resulting from  
13 the study to the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives on or before  
14 December 1, 2017.

15            5 Effective Date.

16                I. Section 4 of this act shall take effect upon its passage.

17                II. The remainder of this act shall take effect May 1, 2018.

**AMENDED ANALYSIS**

This bill establishes an OHRV registration fee for persons who are members of an OHRV club which is reduced \$30 from the increased fee paid by other registrants. The bill also requires the executive director of the fish and game department to report on registration alternatives for OHRV users who do not use organized trail systems.
