## AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill provides that event tents erected on public or private property shall be subject to the requirements of the state building code and state fire code, but shall not be subject to further local regulation. The bill also provides that neither a building permit nor a place of assembly permit shall be required for a tent erected as an accessory structure on owner occupied property that is a one or 2-family dwelling.
