1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT relative to temporary licenses for occupations and professions for persons from
4 other states.

6 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

8 1 New Section; Occupations and Professions; General Provisions; Temporary Licenses or
9 Permits. Amend RSA 332-G by inserting after section 12 the following new section:

10 332-G:13 Temporary Licenses or Permits. The board or commission for any occupation or
11 profession regulated under this title for which existing statutes or rules do not allow for the
12 issuance of a temporary license or permit to an applicant for full licensure while awaiting a
13 determination for such licensure, shall adopt rules as necessary to allow a temporary license or
14 permit to be issued to a person who is currently licensed in any state of the United States or the
15 District of Columbia for 120 days while the person has a pending application for licensure with the
16 respective board or commission regulated under this title. An applicant for a temporary license or
17 permit to practice, who is currently licensed in any state of the United States or the District of
18 Columbia shall:

19 I. Hold an active unencumbered license; and

20 II. Have committed no acts or omissions which are grounds for disciplinary action in
21 another jurisdiction, or, if such acts have been committed, would be grounds for disciplinary action.

22 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
