Amendment to SB 238-FN

1	Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

3	1 Department of Safety; General Provisions; Rulemaking Authority; Commissioner of Safety.
4	Amend RSA 21-P:14, III(gg) to read as follows:
5	(gg) Exemption from municipal permit fees for certain [disabled] veterans, as
6	authorized by RSA 261:157, RSA 261:157-a, and 261:159; and for nonprofit organizations, as
7	authorized by RSA 261:158.
8	2 Certificates of Title and Registration of Vehicles; Municipal Permits for Registration; Local
9	Option Exemption for Certain Other Veterans. Amend RSA 261:157-a to read as follows:
10	261:157-a Local Option; Exemption for [Prisoners of Wars] Certain Other Veterans. The
11	legislative body of a city or town may adopt an ordinance waiving the fee to be charged for a permit
12	to register one motor vehicle owned by any person who [was captured and incarcerated for 30 days
13	or more while serving in a qualifying war or armed conflict as defined in RSA 72:28, V, and who
14	was honorably discharged, provided the person has provided the city or town clerk with satisfactory
15	proof of these circumstances.]:
16	I. Is a former prisoner of war and was captured and incarcerated while serving in
17	a qualifying war or armed conflict as defined in RSA 72:28, V, or while serving in military
18	operations in Iraq and Afghanistan, and who was honorably discharged, provided that
19	such person has furnished the city or town clerk with satisfactory proof of these
20	circumstances;
21	II. Was awarded the Purple Heart medal and who was honorably discharged or is
22	still on active duty, provided that such person has furnished the city or town clerk with
23	satisfactory proof of these circumstances; or

III. Survived Pearl Harbor and was honorably discharged, provided that such

person has furnished the city or town clerk with satisfactory proof of these circumstances.

3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

This bill grants authority to the legislative body of cities and towns to waive the fee for a municipal permit to register a motor vehicle owned by any veteran who is a former prisoner of war, was awarded the Purple Heart medal, or survived Pearl Harbor.
