

Amendment to SB 276-FN-A

1 Amend RSA 188-E:10-b, VI(b) as inserted by section 6 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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3 ***(b) The annual report shall include the progress of the department of***
4 ***education and the career and technical education centers toward:***

5

6 Amend RSA 188-E:2, IX as inserted by section 4 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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8 IX. "Work-based learning" means an educational strategy that offers students an
9 opportunity to reinforce and deepen their classroom learning, explore future career fields, and
10 demonstrate their skills in an authentic setting supported by educators and trained workplace
11 mentors.

13 Amend RSA 188-E:10-b, VI(b)(3) as inserted by section 6 of the bill by replacing it with the
14 following:

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16 ***(3) Establishing annual reporting metrics for school district dual and***
17 ***concurrent course enrollment by class level and extended learning enrollment as defined***
18 ***in rules of the department of education.***

20 Amend the bill by inserting after section 6 the following and renumbering the original sections 7
21 through 9 to read as 8 through 10, respectively:

23 7 Dual and Concurrent Enrollment Program; Program Established. Amend RSA 188-E:26 to
24 read as follows:

25 188-E:26 Program Established. There is established a dual and concurrent enrollment program
26 in the department of education. Participation in the program shall be offered to high school and
27 career technical education center students in grades ~~[11 and]~~ **10 through** 12. The program shall
28 provide opportunities for qualified New Hampshire high school students to gain access and support
29 for dual and concurrent enrollment in STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics)
30 and STEM-related courses that are fundamental for success in postsecondary education and to meet
31 New Hampshire's emerging workforce needs.

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1 Amend RSA 188-E:27, III as inserted by section 8 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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3 III.(a) The state shall pay [~~up to \$250~~] ***the current rate of concurrent enrollment***
4 ***tuition, which is established at \$150 per course***, to the CCSNH institution where a high school
5 or career and technical education student successfully completes [~~an approved~~] ***the concurrent***
6 ***enrollment*** course [~~and the CCSNH shall accept such amount as full payment for course tuition~~].

7 (b) ***The state shall pay the current rate of dual enrollment tuition, which is***
8 ***established at 1/2 the regular cost of the course to the CCSNH institution where a high***
9 ***school or career and technical education student successfully completes a dual***
10 ***enrollment course and the CCSNH shall accept such amount as full payment for course***
11 ***tuition.***

13 Amend the bill by replacing section 9 with the following:

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15 9 Department of Education; Appropriation. The sum of \$500,000 for the fiscal year ending
16 June 30, 2020 is hereby appropriated to the department of education for costs associated with career
17 assessment, transcript development, curricular sequencing guides, adoption of national standards,
18 and reporting. Costs eligible for payment or reimbursement from this sum may be incurred by the
19 department of education or local school districts. This appropriation is in addition to any other
20 funds appropriated to the department of education. The governor is authorized to draw a warrant
21 for said sum out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
