

Amendment to HB 1112-FN

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT establishing a committee to study programs for female parolees.

5 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:  
6

7 1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study programs for female  
8 parolees.

9 2 Membership and Compensation.

10 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

11 (a) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the  
12 house of representatives.

13 (b) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

14 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to  
15 the duties of the committee.

16 3 Duties.

17 I. The committee shall study existing programs for female parolees and shall study whether  
18 the need exists for developing new programs for female parolees focusing on financial counseling,  
19 education including diploma or certificate programs, substance misuse and mental health  
20 counseling, job training including resume writing and interview skills, community housing  
21 programs, and programs available through Medicaid.

22 II. The committee may solicit advice and testimony from any individual or organization with  
23 information or expertise relevant to the committee's objective.

24 4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from  
25 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house  
26 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this  
27 section. Three members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

28 5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed  
29 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house  
30 clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2020.

31 6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
