PROPOSED SUBCOMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to poor persons; providing that state shall deem certain individuals ineligible from receiving certain benefits; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

Pursuant to the authorization given to the states under 7 U.S.C. 214(j), the state shall deem ineligible any individual previously deemed automatically eligible under this statute who maintains over Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) in "liquid resources" as defined below:

1. Cash on hand;
2. Checking or savings account balances;
3. The cash value of savings certificates; and

1 4. The cash value of stocks or bonds.

2 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
