BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 17 O.S. 2011, Section 40, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 40. A. There is hereby created within the Oklahoma
Corporation Commission a division to be known as the Transportation
Division. The Division shall be comprised of a Director and shall
include special motor carrier enforcement officers created by
Section 171.1 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, ~~motor carrier
enforcement officers created by Section 172 of Title 47 of the
Oklahoma Statutes,~~ and such other persons as the Commission may find
necessary to carry out the responsibilities prescribed by law and to
enforce the orders, rules, regulations and judgments of the

Commission except for motor carrier enforcement officers, created by
Section 172 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and point of entry
stations.

B. There shall be a director over the motor carrier enforcement
officers and point of entry officers. The director shall have the
following qualifications:

1. At least ten (10) years of criminal law enforcement
experience;

2. At least three (3) years of experience as a supervisor of
motor vehicle enforcement; and

3. Certified with the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
Training.

C. All motor carrier enforcement officers and point of entry
officers shall be certified with the Council on Law Enforcement
Education and Training.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
