PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to child care; creating the Child Care Center Bill of Rights; listing rights related to training, ratings, terminations, investigations and licensing; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

A new section of law to be codified SECTION 1. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 420 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Child Care Center Bill of Rights includes the following:

- 1. If a child care center employee has completed the required training, the child care center shall not be penalized if computer documentation is not updated;
- 2. If the Department of Human Services reduces the rating of a child care center, the child care center may, within ten (10) days after notice of the rating reduction, appeal to the district court

Req. No. 6787 Page 1 of the county in which the child care center is maintained and operated;

- 3. If a child care center terminates an employee for inappropriate conduct, the child care center shall not be penalized for the conduct;
- 4. When an investigation begins, the Department of Human Services shall notify the child care center that is being investigated and the nature of the allegations. An investigation shall only occur if the alleged incident happened in the preceding twelve (12) months and the scope of the investigation shall be limited to the allegations; and
- 5. If a person or entity sells a child care center, the license for the child care center may be transferred to the new owner.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
