10 An Act relating to schools; amending Section 1,  
11 Chapter 141, O.S.L. 2020 (70 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section  
12 27-104), which relates to emergency medical services  
13 at athletic events or activities; changing act name  
14 to Riley's Rule; requiring development of an  
15 Emergency Action Plan; specifying contents of plan;  
16 providing for annual review, update and rehearsal of  
17 plan; requiring digital transmission of plan prior to  
18 certain athletic events; and providing an effective  
19 date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 141, O.S.L.  
22 2020 (70 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 27-104), is amended to read as  
23 follows:

24 Section 27-104. A. This act shall be known and may be cited as  
the "~~Riley Boatwright Act~~" "Riley's Rule".

B. Prior to the beginning of the ~~2020-2021~~ 2021-2022 school  
year, each school district board of education shall coordinate with

1 ~~the~~ emergency medical services ~~provider~~ providers that ~~serve~~ serve  
2 the area in which the school district is located to develop ~~a plan~~  
3 an Emergency Action Plan for ~~the provision of emergency medical~~  
4 ~~services at~~ each facility and athletic practices, events or  
5 activities held at school district facilities.

6 C. ~~The plan developed pursuant to subsection B of this section~~  
7 Emergency Action Plan shall:

8 1. Include maps and directions with appropriate contact  
9 information for emergency medical services;

10 2. Assign a medical administrator who is a current school  
11 employee such as a coach, administrator or athletic director;

12 3. Define responsibilities and personnel on-site, both medical  
13 and school officials;

14 4. Include a list of medical equipment available and location  
15 of the nearest automated external defibrillator, if available;

16 5. Be posted in each facility;

17 6. Be distributed to all school officials involved in athletic  
18 practices, events or activities held at school district facilities;

19 and

20 7. Specify documentation actions after any emergency to  
21 evaluate for debriefing purposes and to determine if there are  
22 necessary changes to the Emergency Action Plan.

23 D. The Emergency Action Plan shall be reviewed and, updated and  
24 rehearsed annually as appropriate, prior to the start of season

1 practices, with school officials and local emergency medical  
2 services providers, and placed on file with the school district and  
3 the emergency medical services provider.

4 E. Prior to each athletic event or activity where there are  
5 athletes participating from visiting schools, the Emergency Action  
6 Plan shall be digitally transmitted to the visiting school  
7 administrator or coach.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.

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
