PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3437

- On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after "ORS" insert 2 "284.706,".
- 3 On page 46, after line 8, insert:
- 4 **"SECTION 42.** ORS 284.706 is amended to read:
- 5 "284.706. (1) There is created the Oregon Innovation Council consisting of the following voting members:
- "(a) The Governor or the Governor's designated representative, who shall be chairperson of the council.
- "(b) Seven members appointed by the Governor who are experienced entrepreneurs or investors or are engaged in the operations of Oregon traded sector industries or Oregon growth businesses.
- "(c) One member appointed by the Governor who is a representative of an Oregon-based, generally accredited, not-for-profit private institution of higher education.
- "(d) One member appointed by the Governor who is a representative of an Oregon-based, generally accredited public institution of higher education as defined in ORS 284.633.
- 18 "(e) A member of the Oregon Growth Board, appointed by the board, who 19 is experienced in making direct investments in new growth-based companies.
- 20 "(f) A private sector member of the [Oregon Talent Council] State
 21 Workforce and Talent Development Board.

- "(g) The Director or an executive officer of the Oregon Business Development Department.
- 3 "(h) The executive director of the Higher Education Coordinating Com-4 mission.
- 5 "(i) The State Treasurer.

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- 6 "(2)(a) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint two 7 members to the council who are members of the House of Representatives.
- 8 "(b) The President of the Senate shall appoint two members to the council 9 who are members of the Senate.
- "(c) Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the council are nonvoting members and may act in an advisory capacity only.
 - "(3) The presiding officer of the Oregon Business Development Commission shall serve as an ex officio, nonvoting member of the council.
- "(4) The term of office of each appointed voting member of the council is 14 two years, but an appointed member serves at the pleasure of the appointing 15 authority. Before the expiration of the term of an appointed voting member, 16 the appointing authority shall appoint a successor whose term begins on July 17 1 next following. An appointed member is eligible for reappointment for one 18 additional term. If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority 19 shall make an appointment to become immediately effective for the remain-20 der of the unexpired term. 21
 - "(5) A majority of the voting members of the council constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business.
- 24 "(6) Official action by the council requires the approval of a majority of 25 the voting members of the council.
- "(7) The council shall meet at least four times per fiscal year at a place, day and time determined by the chairperson. The council may also meet at other times and places specified by a call of the chairperson or by written request of a majority of the voting members of the council.
 - "(8) The council may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the

1 council.

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- "(9) The council shall establish an audit and accountability committee that shall monitor performance of council contracts and benchmark Oregon's performance against nationally accepted innovation metrics.
- 5 "(10) The council may establish other committees and delegate to the committees duties as the council considers desirable.
- 7 "(11) The Oregon Business Development Department shall provide staff 8 support to the council.
- "(12) Members of the council who are members of the Legislative Assembly are entitled to compensation and expense reimbursement as provided in ORS 171.072.
- "(13) Members of the council who are not members of the Legislative 12 Assembly are entitled to compensation and expenses incurred by them in the 13 performance of their official duties in the manner and amounts provided for 14 in ORS 292.495. Claims for compensation and expenses of members of the 15 council who are public officers shall be paid out of funds appropriated to the 16 public agency that employs the member. Claims for compensation and ex-17 penses of members of the council who are not public officers shall be paid 18 out of funds appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department 19 for that purpose. 20
 - "(14) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist the council in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the council consider necessary to perform their duties."
