- 9 Section 1. The following integrated amendments to the 10 Constitution of Pennsylvania are proposed in accordance with 11 Article XI:
  - (1)That section 2 of Article II be amended to read:
- 13 § 2. Election of members; vacancies.

Members of the General Assembly shall be chosen at the general election [every second year]. Their term of service shall begin on the first day of December next after their election. Whenever a vacancy shall occur in either House, the presiding officer thereof shall issue a writ of election to fill such vacancy for the remainder of the term.

- (2) That section 3 of Article II be amended to read: § 3. Terms of members.
- [Senators] (a) Except as provided under subsection (b), members shall be elected for the term of four years [and Representatives for the term of two years].
- 25 (b) At the first general election after the adoption of the 26 amendment adding this subsection, members from odd-numbered 27 districts shall be elected for terms of two years.
- Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General 28 29 Assembly of these proposed constitutional amendments, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to 30
- 31 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 32
- required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 33
- which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 34
- 35 passage of these proposed constitutional amendments.

(b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of these 2 proposed constitutional amendments, the Secretary of the 3 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 4 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 5 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 6 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 8 these proposed constitutional amendments. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall submit the proposed constitutional amendments 9 10 under section 1 of this resolution to the qualified electors of 11 this Commonwealth as a single ballot question at the first 12 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 13 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article 14 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 15 three months after the proposed constitutional amendments are 16 passed by the General Assembly.
