1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 17, by inserting after "custody"

3 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 10 through 21, by striking out all
4 of lines 10 through 20 and "(b)" in line 21 and inserting

6 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 25 through 30, by striking out all
7 of said lines and inserting

8 (b) Eligibility.--

9 (1) A law enforcement agency or municipality that
10 refuses to enforce an immigration order shall not be
11 eligible:

12 (i) for any State grant; or

13 (ii) to participate in the sale of State surplus
14 property.

15 (2) This subsection shall not apply to a law enforcement
16 agency or municipality that has made an attempt to coordinate
17 with a Federal agency pursuant to an immigration order to
18 transfer the custody of a suspect in question but was unable
19 to do so within the time frame requested by Federal
20 immigration officials up to a maximum of 48 hours, excluding
21 weekends and holidays, of extended custody.

4 (d) Enforcement.--Each State agency and executive department
5 offering State grants or overseeing the sale of State surplus
6 property to municipalities shall require each municipality to
7 verify under penalty of perjury that the municipality is not a
8 municipality of refuge and is in compliance with subsection (a).
