11 Section 1716.1-A. Publication of E-mail Addresses for Board
12 of Trustees.--Within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
13 effective date of this section, each charter school shall
14 establish and publish on its publicly accessible Internet
15 website an e-mail address for each member of the board of
16 trustees which may be used by members of the public, charter
17 school staff and students to communicate with individual board
18 members regarding matters of charter school governance. Such e-
19 mail addresses shall be published in a location and manner that
20 are easily visible and accessible to the public.
