**EMPLOYABILITY TO CAREERS PROGRAM**

Senator **Allen M. Christensen** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 5, Line 145 through Page 6, Line 154:*

- 145           (1) There is created within the office the Employability to Careers Program Board  
146 composed of the following members:

sector and who has expertise in pay-for-success programs; and  
              (iii) one member recommended by the speaker of the House of Representatives who is from the  
private or nonprofit sector and who has expertise in pay-for-success programs.  
150           (2) (a) ~~{A}~~ An appointed member of the board shall serve for a term of three years, but may  
              be  
151 reappointed for one additional term.  
152           (b) If a vacancy occurs in the board for any reason, the ~~{person appointing the board~~  
153 member} governor with the consent of the Senate shall appoint a replacement to serve the remainder  
of the board member's term.
