MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT PROGRAM FOR FIRST RESPONDERS

Representative **Karen Kwan** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 40 through 43:*

40 (vii) a correctional officer, as defined in Section 53-13-104.

41 (b) "First responder {~~district~~} agency " means {the same as that term is defined in
Section

42 ~~17B-1-505.~~} a local district, municipality, interlocal entity, or other political subdivision that
employs a first responder to provide fire protection, paramedic, law enforcement, or emergency
services.

76 (6) Before June 30, 2022, the division shall report to the Law Enforcement and
