4 six-tenths grams per day, more than seven and two-tenths grams in  
5 a thirty-day period or more than"

7 On page 1, line 17, by inserting a new subdivision (1), to  
8 read as follows:

9 "(1) Before dispensing a product containing ephedrine,  
10 pseudoephedrine, or phenylpropanolamine under subsection (a), a  
11 pharmacist shall make a professional determination, based on a  
12 pharmacist-patient relationship, as to whether or not there is a  
13 legitimate medical and pharmaceutical need for the drug.

14 (A) This determination shall be based on factors including  
15 without limitation:

16 (I) Prior medication-filling history;

17 (ii) Patient screening;

18 (iii) Other tools that provide professional reassurance to the  
19 pharmacist that a legitimate medical and pharmaceutical need  
20 exists; and

21 (iv) The Multi-State Real Time Tracking System"

22 And renumbering the remaining subdivisions accordingly.
