"(a) The legislature finds that federal funding and the resulting capacity for responsible management of federal public lands are in serious jeopardy while critical threats such as beetle kills, invasive species, watershed degradation, access restrictions and catastrophic wildfires continue to escalate.

1 2 (b) The legislature further finds that the enabling act 3 creating the state of Wyoming includes specific provisions for 4 the disposal of public lands and guarantees admittance into the 5 union on equal footing with all other states. Wyoming, like 6 other western states, has not received the full benefit of the 7 provisions of the enabling act, related to the disposal of lands from the federal government. More specifically, section 7 of the 9 act of admission requires "Five percent of the proceeds of the sales of public lands lying within said state .... shall be paid 10 11 to the said state .... for the support of the common schools 12 within said state.".
