

Page 1-line 3 After "budget" insert "; placing limitations
on delegates".

Page 3-After line 4 Insert:

"Section 3. That this application contains the following
limits and provisions:

(a) No delegate shall have authority to vote to allow
consideration of, or to approve, an unauthorized amendment for
ratification to the United States constitution.

(b) Any delegate shall be directed to vote for procedures
and rules mandating that the convention remain a convention of
states where each state is represented by one (1) vote.

(c) Any vote made in violation of subsection (a) or (b) of
this section shall be null and void, and the delegate making the
vote shall be immediately recalled by an official or executive
branch committee authorized by a resolution of the legislature
and replaced by an alternate as provided in subsection (g) of
this section.

(d) Each delegate or alternate shall be required to take
the following oath or affirmation: "I do solemnly swear or
affirm that to the best of my abilities I will, as a delegate or
alternate to an article V convention, uphold the constitution
and laws of the United States of America and Wyoming. I will not
vote to allow consideration of or to approve any unauthorized
amendment proposed for ratification to the United States
constitution. I understand and accept any penalties that Wyoming
law may impose on me for violating this oath."

(e) Any delegate who violates the oath contained in
subsection (d) of this section shall be guilty of a felony
punishable by imprisonment for not more than five (5) years, a
fine of not more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), or
both. Additionally, any delegate who violates the oath contained
in subsection (d) of this section shall be ineligible to serve
as a delegate and any certification of the delegate shall be
null and void.

(f) The secretary of state shall certify the selection of
the delegates in writing to the article V convention and shall

1 provide a copy of the certification to each delegate. No
2 delegate shall have authority to vote or otherwise serve as a
3 delegate at the article V convention without the certification.
4

5 (g) The secretary of state shall notify the president of
6 the Wyoming senate and the speaker of the Wyoming house of
7 representatives in writing of the need to assign delegates or
8 alternates to the article V convention. The members of the
9 senate shall elect three (3) members of the senate to serve as
10 delegates, and the members of the house of representatives shall
11 elect three (3) members of the house of representatives to serve
12 as delegates. If a delegate becomes unable or ineligible to
13 serve, the president of the senate or the speaker of the house
14 shall assign an alternate for the delegate who has become unable
15 or ineligible to serve. An alternate delegate assigned under
16 this subsection shall immediately be entitled to represent
17 Wyoming as a delegate in place of the delegate who has become
18 unable or ineligible to serve, and the secretary of state shall
19 immediately provide certification to the new delegate.

21 (h) The secretary of state shall notify the article V
22 convention and any delegate involved of the revocation of that
23 delegate's certification should the delegate violate his or her
24 oath to act only within the limits of the authority granted by
25 the state of Wyoming.

27 (j) The Wyoming attorney general shall enforce the
28 provisions of this section. A Wyoming citizen may also file an
29 action to enforce the requirements of this chapter and shall be
30 entitled to reasonable attorney's fees if successful.

32 (k) As used in this resolution:
33

34 (i) "Article V application" means a joint resolution
35 passed by the Wyoming legislature on the same subject or
36 containing the same proposed amendment text as two-thirds (2/3)
37 of the other states requiring the United States congress to call
38 an article V convention;

40 (ii) "Article V convention" means a convention for
41 proposing amendments as expressly provided in article V of the
42 United States constitution;

44 (iii) "Delegate" or "alternate" means a legislator
45 selected under subsection (g) of this section to represent the
46 state of Wyoming at an article V convention;
47

1 (iv) "Legislative instructions" means instructions
2 given by the state legislature to delegates and alternates
3 before and during an article V convention;
4

5 (v) "Unauthorized amendment" means a proposed
6 amendment that is outside the permitted subject matter contained
7 in the article V application or contrary to legislative
8 instructions.".
