

1 Delete the Senate standing committee amendment (HB0040SS001/AE)
2 entirely and further amend as follows:

4 Page 3-after line 2 Insert and renumber as necessary:
5

6 "(e) The select committee shall undertake a preliminary study
7 to examine the educational programs for schools established under
8 W.S. 21-9-101 and other Wyoming law. The study shall include any
9 potential modifications to the educational programs necessary to
10 ensure the programs are proper and fit for purpose. As part of
11 this analysis, the select committee shall work with professional
12 consultant experts for national educational program best practices
13 or other consultants. The legislative service office, subject to
14 the approval of management council, shall retain professional
15 consulting experts for the purposes of this act. The study under
16 this subsection shall include consideration of alternatives to the
17 educational programs for schools which shall be developed in
18 consultation with relevant stakeholders and the advisory committee
19 as provided in subsection (f) of this section. The select committee
20 shall develop a framework for considering alternative educational
21 programs under this subsection.
22

23 (f) The select committee shall be assisted by an advisory
24 committee to provide information to the select committee as it
25 deems necessary to carry out subsection (e) of this section. The
26 advisory committee shall consist of the following members:
27

28 (i) One (1) member who is a superintendent of a large
29 Wyoming school district and one (1) member who is a superintendent
30 of a small Wyoming school district, appointed by the Wyoming
31 association of school administrators;

33 (ii) One (1) member who is serving as a trustee on a
34 Wyoming school district board of trustees appointed by the state
35 superintendent of public instruction;
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37 (iii) One (1) member who is serving on the Wyoming state
38 board of education designated by the state superintendent of public
39 instruction;

41 (iv) A representative of the department of education
42 designated by the state superintendent of public instruction;

1 (v) A representative of the governor designated by the
2 governor;

4 (vi) Two (2) members who are parents of a child enrolled
5 in a Wyoming school district appointed by the governor;

7 (vii) A student enrolled in a Wyoming school district
8 appointed by the governor;

9
10 (viii) A representative of the Wyoming business
11 community appointed by the governor.

13 (g) Appointments to the advisory committee pursuant to
14 subsection (f) of this section shall be made not later than March
15 31, 2020. The appointing authority for any member who vacates an
16 appointment shall fill the vacancy. Any member appointed to the
17 advisory committee who is not an employee of a government entity
18 or political subdivision, or a member of a political subdivision
19 board or commission, shall receive per diem and travel expenses in
20 the manner and amount provided to state employees under W.S. 9-3-
21 103. Reimbursement shall be made from amounts appropriated under
22 subsection (m) of this section."
